

Substance use disorders have always been higher than the societal norm in the legal profession. Most lawyers know someone in the legal profession whose career was either lost or significantly harmed due to addiction. The associated shame and fear of judgment can inhibit a lawyer from disclosing these issues until there both physical and employment consequences. 
